NASCAR Automotive Technician of the Year

The NASCAR Automotive Technician of the Year Award recognizes the behind-the-scenes worker who plays a very important role in auto racing — the crew chief.

The award, which is sponsored by D & D Auto Clinic of Alexandria, honors the crew chief of the team with the highest percentage of top five heat races and feature finishes among all the NASCAR race teams in each division.

Scores are tabulated by using the team's best 40 starts.

This year's top crew chiefs are as follows:

Technician of the Year — Rich Atkinson, Sr., crew chief for the #21 Pro-Four Modified driven by Scott Atkinson. The team had 29 top five finishes in 30 starts for a percentage of 96.67.

- NASCAR Pure Stock — Jon Stepan (25) of Alexandria

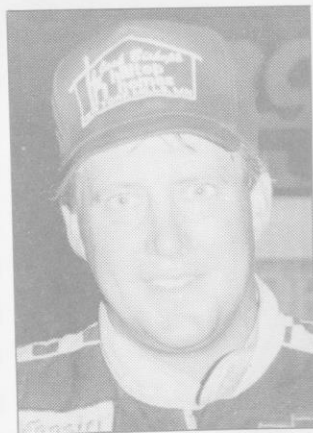
At the close of the July 8 program, there was actually a tie in the NASCAR Super Stock Division between Dickenson and Larry Lund (54) of Brandon.

The winner was determined by adding the number of feature wins for the season, which named Dickenson the winner.

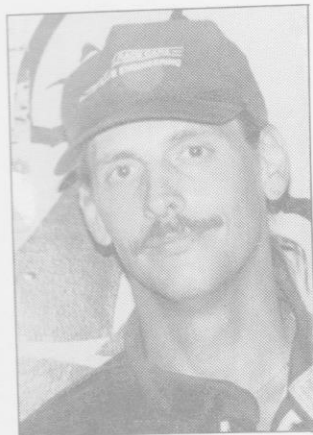
The top five drivers were kept in suspense until July 22, when the drawing for the trip took place.

Each driver was given a ping-pong ball with their car number written on it. The numbers were put in a box, and the last ball drawn out was the winner of the trip.

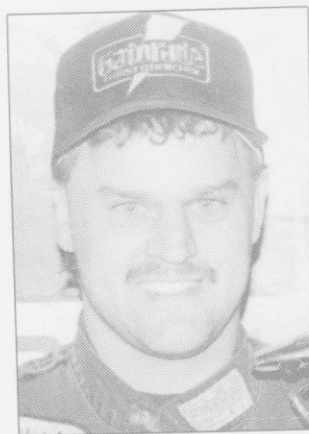
